The NLSY79. The National Longitudinal Survey of Youth (NLSY79) is a multipurpose survey of more than 12,600 individuals in the U.S. who were initially interviewed in 1979 when they were 14 to 21 years of age. Sponsored by the Department of Labor, Bureau of Labor Statistics (BLS), the NLSY79 contains extensive information about the employment, education, training, and family experiences of the respondents. Since 1982, through support of the National Institute of Child Health and Human Development (NICHD), questions have been asked about pregnancy and postnatal histories, fertility, and child care. The Center for Human Resource Research (CHRR) at The Ohio State University and NORC at the University of Chicago are responsible for the design, collection, and dissemination of the NLSY79.

NLSY79 Child & Young Adult Surveys. Starting in 1986, and every two years thereafter, the children of the NLSY79 mothers have been assessed to measure their cognitive ability, temperament, motor and social development, behavior problems, perceived competence, and the quality of their home environment. This assessment information, combined with data from the mothers' records, forms a detailed record for users interested in exploring the interrelationships of individual, family and environmental factors related to maternal behavior and child development. Starting in 1994, young adult children who have reached age 15 are no longer assessed but administered a questionnaire in which they are asked detailed questions similar to those asked of their mothers on employment, education, training, fertility, health, and attitudes.

NLSY79 Child & Mother Bibliographies. This document cites research on the fertility and child care experiences of the NLS main Youth79 female respondents as well as research on the health and well being of the children of the NLSY79 mothers. References to published works are listed first, followed by theses and dissertations. The final section lists working papers and meeting presentations.
